CODE OF CONDUCT

1. School lessons shall run from Monday to Thursday starting at 08h00 to 14h30. Fridays starting at 08h00 to 13h30. There could be extra lessons should a teacher feel necessary.
2. Punctuality shall be observed at all times and hence lateness shall be regarded as an act of misconduct.
3. **ABSENTISM AND TRUANCY** shall not be tolerated. Should any student be absent due to illness or any other reason, a letter ascertaining this shall be produced to the class teacher.
4. No student shall be allowed to smoke, drink alcohol or take drugs or in possession of any drugs in the school premises or in uniform.
5. Selling drugs is an automatic expulsion from school.
6. Fighting and any form of violence will not be tolerated.
7. No gun or any weapons shall be allowed into the school premises
8. Foul language and theft shall not be tolerated no matter what circumstances
9. Learners must respect their educators and school prefects at all times
10. All students shall be expected to have a high level of discipline at all times
11. English shall be the medium of communication
12. Gender and Race equality shall be observed and hence no student shall be discriminated against gender, race or religion
13. Learners shall keep noise levels to a minimum
14. No student shall be allowed to leave the school premises during school hours.
15. All students shall leave the College at the same stipulated time even if they have free periods.
16. Students shall wear school colours during sports and other activities
17. Letters, school reports and any other written communication from the school should reach parents and signatures of parents shall be proof of receipt.
18. Cell phones found to be disturbing lessons or any other school activities shall be confiscated and a release fee of R100 shall be charged.
19. Any student acting against any stipulated code of conduct shall be brought before disciplinary committee and expulsion shall be the final disciplinary action where possible.
